Location

Kitsap County Admin Building, 619 Division Street, Port Orchard, WA 98366. The ceremony will be on the outdoor plaza, so dress for weather.

General Directions

The Kitsap County Admin Building is located at the top of a steep hill across the street from the County Courthouse. Although Division Street will be closed to through traffic, parking is close by.

We recommend the following route to the ceremony:

From Hwy 16, take the Tremont exit and head east on Tremont for 9/10 of a mile and turn left onto Sidney Avenue. Go north on Sidney for one mile to the county campus.

Parking Port Orchard Ceremony Only

Park on Sidney or any side street where you are allowed to park legally. There is also a public parking lot 100 feet south of the Sidney Avenue and Division Street intersection.

Parking Port Orchard Ceremony and Funeral Cortège to Tahoma National Cemetery

There are special parking areas for motorcycles and automobiles for those wishing to go on to Tahoma National Cemetery following the ceremony.

Once you turn onto Sidney Avenue, go 9/10 of a mile and turn west onto Taylor Street. Follow the signs and traffic officers to the cortège assembly areas for cars or automobiles.

Motorcycle organizations are encouraged to arrive as a group rather than have members arrive individually.
