

Military/Veteran Trauma Informed Care Trainings

Free trainings are available for community and clinical providers in King County, funded by the Veterans and Human Services Levy. These trainings cover topics such as military and veteran culture, Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI), Post-traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), Military Sexual Trauma (MST), and resources and benefits for veterans.

We are providing Basic and Advanced trainings. Basic Trauma Training, is for organizations that may have some contact with veterans but do not provide treatment. Advanced Trauma Treatment, is for those organizations or private practitioners that provide clinical services, such as mental health counseling or chemical dependency services. The advanced training covers more of the treatment options and techniques that are used with returning veterans suffering from trauma. These trainings are conducted by veterans and licensed professionals experienced with working with the military, veterans and their families on issues related to their return from combat zones of the past and present.
