Boating registration dollars fund derelict vessel removal, invasive species removal, and boating programs. Increasing compliance not only identifies vessels that have been abandoned, but increases funding available to other programs that improve the Puget Sound and reward boaters the have already complied with the states registration laws.

Position will conduct a Puget Sound Vessel registration survey and compliance improvement effort at moorage facilities. After obtaining permission from marinas, position would visit moorage facilities and document vessels that are not displaying current registration.

Position will coordinate enforcement so that dock walking efforts are not duplicated. Position will refer to law enforcement for follow up.
