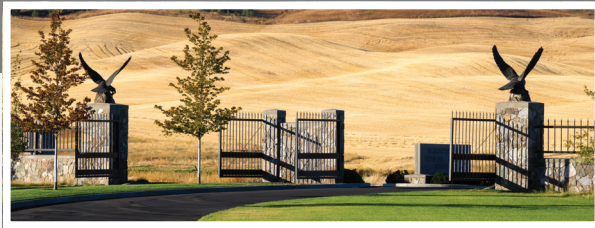

HISTORY

The Washington State Department of Veterans Affairs began construction on the State Veterans Cemetery at Medical Lake in 2009.

The \$14 million project is a partnership between the Washington Department of Veterans Affairs and the Federal VA Cemetery Construction Grant Program.

BURIAL BENEFITS

Eligibility for interment in the State Veterans Cemetery mirrors National Veterans Cemetery eligibility requirements. In general, U.S. veterans discharged under conditions other than dishonorable and their spouses are eligible. Dependent children may be eligible.

INTERMENT COSTS

WDVA provides the following benefits for Veterans:

- Burial plot or columbarium niche
- Concrete Liner for casket burials
- Opening and closing of the grave
- Perpetual care of the gravesite
- Inscribed gravestone
- 30 minute committal service

All other death related expenses are the responsibility of the Veteran's family/estate. There is a \$300 fee for qualifying family member interments which is subject to change.

TYPES OF INTERMENT OFFERED

The State Veterans Cemetery provides for in-ground casket burial sites and cremation interments. Columbarium niches, in-ground cremation inurnment and a scattering garden are available for cremation interments.



ABOUT THE CEMETERY

Office Hours Monday–Friday 8am to 4pm. Grounds are open for public visitation from 8am to sunset daily. *Please note severe winter weather may prohibit access to the grounds on affected weekends and holidays.*

SCHEDULING AN INTERMENT

Interment services are conducted Monday–Friday between 9am and 2:30pm in a committal shelter. Grave-side services are not offered. Guests requiring unique ADA accommodations should inform staff upon arrival.

Individuals may pre-register to establish interment eligibility.

Cemetery staff only arrange military funeral honors for veterans interred at this site.
