The VCC helps veterans define their new mission after leaving military service.

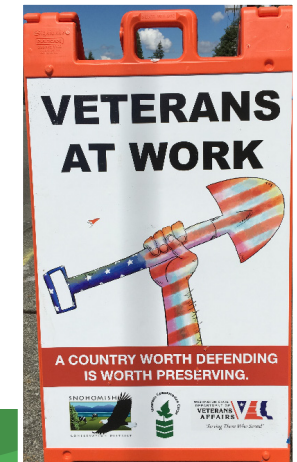
VCC PARTNERS
