Emblem Fund FAQ

What is the Emblem Fund?

Veterans Remembrance Emblem Program permits eligible veterans to purchase and display approved decals (U.S. Flag, U.S. Veteran and replicas of several campaign ribbons) on their vehicle license plates. The fees paid for the emblems go into an account to be used for memorials.

How can it be used?

 Projects that pay tribute to living and deceased veterans, who have defended our nation's freedom;
Upkeep and operations of existing memorials; and
Land acquisition and construction of new memorials.

You may request funds each year for different phases until the project is complete.

When does my application have to be in?

Proposals for Emblem Funds can be submitted at any time and will be held until the next Request for Proposals is released.

Does WDVA disburse funds every year?

WDVA may, or may not, provide grants each year depending on the account balance.
