Dear Residents, Families, Resident Representatives, and Staff:

This letter is intended to provide an update our COVID-19 status at the Walla Walla Veterans Home. The WA Department of Veterans Affairs revised the notification letter format a couple of months ago to allow you to easily scan for changes. These letters are sent out to provide up-to-date information on COVID-19 in the Veterans Homes, and to meet the notification requirements of CMS and L&I.

We are working closely with our local Health Department, Centers for Disease Control, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), and our State and Local Departments of Health, and following their guidance and to ensure we are safeguarding our residents and staff.
