Dear Residents, Families, Resident Representatives, and Staff:

This letter is intended to provide an update our COVID-19 status at the Walla Walla Veterans Home. These letters are sent out to provide up-to-date information on COVID-19 in the WA State Veterans Homes, and to meet notification requirements of CMS and L&I.

We are closely following the most current guidance from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), and our state and local Departments of Health to ensure we are safeguarding our residents and staff.

Healthcare Setting COVID-19 Outbreak Definition: 1 or more COVID-19 case(s) which originated in the veterans home in a resident OR 3 or more suspected, probable, or confirmed COVID-19 cases in Healthcare Personnel linked to facility exposure AND no other more likely sources of exposure for at least 1 of the cases.

**Visitation, Group Activities, and Dining Rooms:** No change to current protocols. Families of residents in the affected neighborhood are notified and provided the appropriate guidance.

**REMINDER FOR ALL VISITORS:** Please always screen-in at the COVID-19 screening kiosk in the entry of the house you're visiting <u>PRIOR TO contact with residents</u> or staff. If you have been exposed to a positive case and/or have symptoms (*or potential symptoms*), it is best to either stay away from WWVH until symptoms have subsided, or test at home before coming to the facility, or call us in advance so we can assist you here. If you test positive and have been at the facility at any time within the week prior, PLEASE notify us by calling our Infection Preventionist at **509-394-6808**.
