- Co-located with gynecology, mental health, social work, pharmacy, nutrition and excellent nurse care managers

Community Outreach & Homelessness Program

- Strong grassroot partnerships at all levels—federal, state, local that place needs of our Veterans front and center
- 140-person team of social workers, addiction counselors, physicians, nurse practitioners, registered nurses, occupational therapists, housing specialists, peer support specialists, employment specialists & administrative support

 Programs: HUD-VASH (2,600 vouchers), Grant and Per Diem (186 beds), contracted residential (32 beds), Homeless Primary Care Team, drop-in services, community outreach, Veterans Justice Outreach
