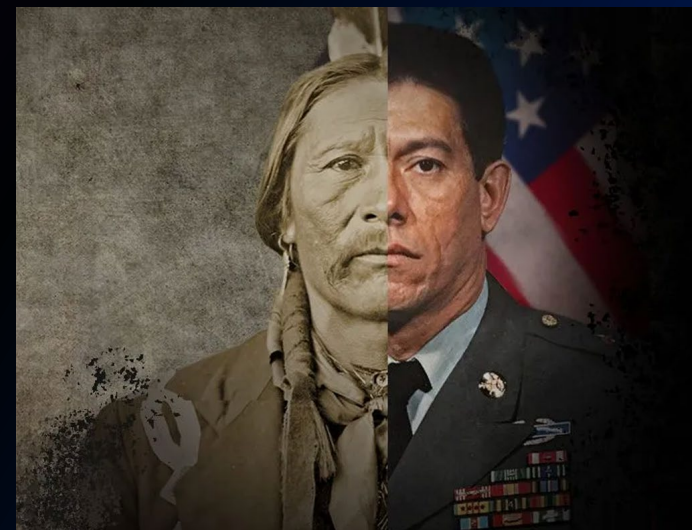
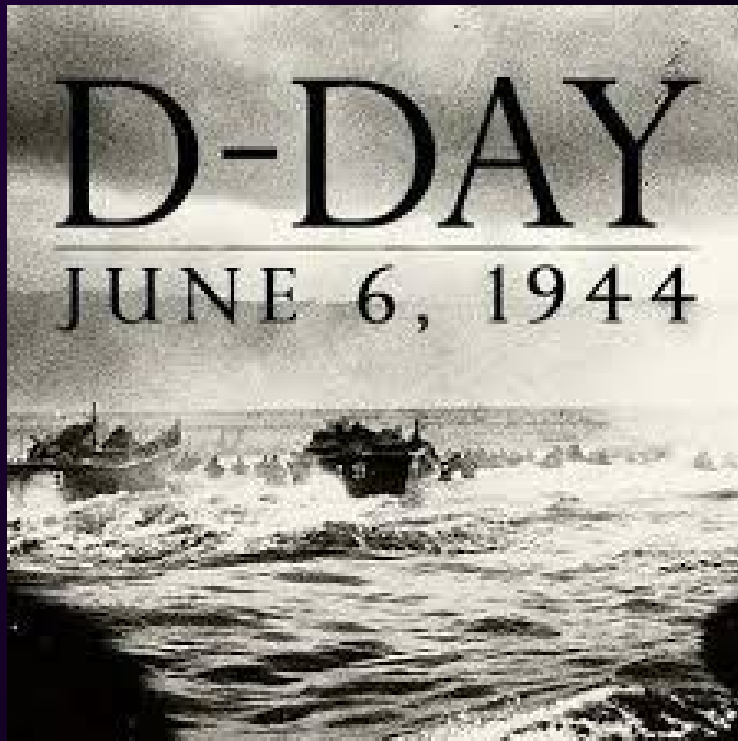
Main Medical Center Campus

PACT ACT:

- Toxic Exposure
- Air Pollutants
- Chemicals
- Occupational Hazards
- Radiation / Warfare agents

COMPACT ACT:

- Guarantees Veterans in Suicidal Crisis will receive care
- VA will provide treatment or cover all costs (transportation, inpatient – 30days)

DID YOU SERVE HERE?



If you served on the ground, in the airspace above, in territorial waters, or a ship that called there, you may be eligible for VA benefits and health care for over 300 conditions.

YOU MIGHT HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO:



AIR POLLUTANTS:
Burn pits, oil well fires, sulfur fire, sand, dust, and particulates



RADIATION:
Nuclear weapons testing and ionizing radiation



CHEMICALS:
Agent Orange or other herbicides, pesticides, and depleted uranium



WARFARE AGENTS:
Chemical warfare agents, nerve agents, and mustard gas



OCCUPATIONAL HAZARDS:
Asbestos, lead, fuels, and industrial solvents

Service members may have been subjected to any of these exposures in any of these areas.
